How Do I Join?



Individuals may become a member of First Presbyterian Church by one of the following methods:

Profession of Faith

A person who has never been a member of any Christian church, or who has been baptized but never officially joined the church, makes a profession of faith in Jesus Christ.

Certificate of Transfer

A person who is a member of another Christian church and wishes to unite with First Presbyterian Church may request that First Presbyterian Church ask for a letter of transfer.

Reaffirmation of Faith

A person who is a member of one of those churches and wishes to join First Presbyterian Church will be asked to reaffirm his/her faith in Jesus Christ. Some churches do not transfer members or a church's membership records may not be available.

Affiliate Membership

A person who is a member of another Christian church but who will only temporarily be in Spartanburg. An affiliate member is officially connected to First Presbyterian while maintaining membership in his/her present church.
